Theory of Convergence in the State of End(less) Ideology Summary

Two dominant political system were present at the world stage by the mid of the twentieth century that besides their prominent formal diversities, existed essentially in the same economic circumstance that enabled their approach. Those circumstances are the consequence of historical processes where one system is modified and adapted to the new conditions, and another one, because of its historical beginning, burdened with the beginner's weaknesses, seeks for the solution in political system that it itself cancelled. Both Communism and Capitalism acquire characteristics of political systems highly under state control with scientific technological development as a priority and trying to find possibility for social justice for the majority of their inhabitants.

Cold war was the period full of suspicions, intolerance, but also open confrontation of two at that time dominant political – economic world systems. Official state policies aspired to make differences in all fields more prominent – from cultural to military doctrine thus putting as much distance between two political systems as possible. Opposite to this kind of politics, theoreticians of the social changes recognized in the present political practice many mutual things. Behind the historic everyday life recognizable to superficial observer, they recognize common denominator of both dominant systems.
